

PRIVACY POLICY

This website www.publieurope.com (the 'Site') is brought to you by Publieurope Limited. We take the privacy of our Site users very seriously. We ask that you read this Privacy Policy ('the Policy') carefully as it contains important information about how we will use your personal data.

By visiting this Site you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this Policy.

For the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998 ('the Act'), Publieurope Limited ('we' or 'us') is the 'data controller' (i.e. the company who is responsible for, and controls the processing of, your personal data).

1. Personal data we may collect about you

We will obtain personal data about you such as your name, e-mail address, location, employer name and sector whenever you complete an online form.

For example, we will obtain your personal data when you sign up to receive our monthly updates.

2. How we use your personal data

We will use your personal data for the purposes described in the privacy policy that was given to you at the time your data was obtained. These purposes include:

- a) administration;
- b) providing you with our monthly updates; and
- c) notifying you of any changes to this Site or to our services which may affect you.

3. Disclosure of your personal data

We may disclose your personal data to other companies within our group companies and with the Mediaset Group (also known as *Gruppo Mediaset*) and law enforcement agencies in connection with any investigation to help prevent unlawful activity.

4. Keeping your personal data secure

We will use technical and organisational measures to safeguard your personal data, for example, we store your personal data on secure servers.

Whilst we will use all reasonable efforts to safeguard your personal data, you acknowledge that the use of the internet is not entirely secure and for this reason we cannot guarantee the security or integrity of any personal data which is transferred from you or to you via the internet.

5. Information about other individuals

If you give us information on behalf of someone else, you confirm that the other person has appointed you to act on his/her behalf and has agreed that you can:

- a) give consent on his/her behalf to the processing of his or her personal data; and
- b) receive on his/her behalf any data protection notices.

6. Use of cookies

A cookie is a small text file which may be placed onto your device when you access a website in order to distinguish you from other users.

We do not use cookies on this Site.
